A Santa Fe spokesman said a crew of 50 to 75 men worked Monday replacing sections of damaged track and removing

WASHINGTON (UPI)

The conference committee,—
on a 124 vote, adopted an amendment by Sen. Henry Jackson, Dwash, that would roll back prices to \$5.25 a barrel and put a ceiling of \$7.09 a barrel on crude oil that has been selling for up to \$10.25.

JACKSON estimated the provison could push gasoline prices down by about 5½ cents a gallon, and could open the way for Senate approval of the emergency legislation which has been hanging fire since the last session of Congress.


